How can we re-capture the explosive power of the resurrection that ricocheted around the world? How can we live in the glow of resurrection and be an Easter people? How can 'there and then' become 'here and now'?

CTIS have set up groups around the town that, for the convenience of participants, will meet on different mornings, afternoons or evenings throughout the 5 weeks of Lent. Each small group will have a host and a group facilitator to help participants obtain the most benefit from the sessions. Meetings will usually take place in someone's home and will normally last approximately one and half hours. The **5 WEEK COURSE** will begin in the week commencing 19th February 2018. A booklet accompanying the course includes questions & discussion topics for groups.

The total cost of the course, (including the price of the course booklet and all other material) will be £5.50 per person. [Whilst it is preferable for everyone to have their own booklet, for those wishing to share with a partner a reduced fee of £2.50 will apply]. Payment will be due during the first group session.
